NAME OF CREATOR	Mittagong Municipal Council, Mittagong Shire Council and Nattai Shire Council
DATE RANGE	July 1889 to January 1939 ; 1949 to 1980 and 1906-1948

Administrative History Mittagong Municipal Council:

Mittagong Municipal Council was gazetted 24 July 1889. The election of Aldermen was held 21 September 1889, and William Middleton, Charles Sheather, Thomas Viles, Robert Snowden, Frederick Draper, William Richards, Henry W Edwards , Edward Dawson and John Mealing (First Mayor) were elected. The first meeting was held 30 September 1889.

Mittagong Municipal Council amalgamated with Nattai Shire Council 1 January 1939 under the name Nattai Shire Council.

Nattai Shire Council changed its name to Mittagong Shire Council in March 1949.

DATE RANGE	December 1906 to February 1905

Administrative History:

Under the 1905 Local Government (Shires) Act and the Local Government Extension Act 1906 the land surrounding Mittagong became Nattai Shire Council in December 1906. Nattai Shire Council and Mittagong Municipal Council operated concurrently until 1 January 1939 when Mittagong Municipality amalgamated with Nattai Shire to become Nattai Shire Council. The Amalgamation was proclaimed in the Government Gazette of the State of New South Wales, Friday 23 December 1938 (No.188), page 4856. Schedule B describes boundaries for Ridings A, B, C and D.

In March 1949 the Council adopted the name Mittagong Shire Council.

DATE RANGE	1949 to 1980

Administrative History:

Nattai Shire Council changed its name to Mittagong Shire Council in March 1949.

Prior to 1981 amalgamation with Wingecarribee Shire Council, Mittagong Council was dismissed by the Minister and Jim Gasson was appointed administrator.
