Terms and Conditions:

Entries are to be based on the theme "Tiny door on a spring day". Entries must be a short story and not exceed the word limit for the entrant's age group. Each individual entry must have a completed entry form attached. All personal information gathered by the competition organisers will be used solely for the purposes of administering the Tulip Time Young Writers Competition 2023. Entries must be the entrants own original work. Entries will be judged anonymously by 2 library staff members and 2 representatives from FOWL. The judging panel and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition. To ensure anonymity the author's name must not appear on the story itself, only on the entry form. Wingecarribee Shire Council reserves the right to publish the winning entries for not for profit and promotional purposes. Winners will be contacted directly. First place entrants in each category will each be awarded a \$100 voucher. Runners up will each receive a \$50 voucher.

All entries must be received by FRIDAY 6 October 2023.

Winners will be announced in OCTOBER 2023.
