

HOW TO ENTER

1. Create an original LEGO® masterpiece inspired by Tulip Time, flowers, gardens, nature, or the beauty of the Southern Highlands.
2. Complete the online entry form by scanning the QR code or visiting <https://bit.ly/441RyH8>.
3. Select your age category and preferred display branch: Bowral, Mittagong or Moss Vale Library.
4. Upload up to three photos of your creation for judging.
5. Submit your entry by Monday 7 September 2026.

FINALISTS & PEOPLE'S CHOICE

The top five finalists in each age category will be invited to display their creations at their chosen library branch during Tulip Time. Visitors can vote for their favourite entry, with a People's Choice Award presented in each age category.

COMPETITION RULES

- Free entry.
- Entrants must be a library member, one entry per person.
- Open to children and teens aged 5–14 years.
- Creations must be primarily made from LEGO® or compatible building bricks.
- **Maximum size: 25 cm x 25 cm (base) and 25 cm high** to fit inside the display cubes
- Entries must be original creations.
- By entering, participants agree that photographs of their creation may be used by Wingecarribee Libraries for promotional purposes.
- While Wingecarribee Libraries will take every reasonable care to protect entries while on display, no responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Entries will be judged on:

- Creativity
- Connection to the Tulip Time theme *Together We Bloom*
- Design and construction
